

I started writing letters to my future husband in the year 2014. Anytime I thought about love and relationships, I would either write to God or write to my future husband. Those letters later found their way to my blog in a category I tagged “Frances’ Love Letters”.

The first time I felt led to pray for my future husband was in 2015. I was on some errands with my boss when I suddenly felt the need to pray for him – the man whose name I did not know.

I examined the thought and wondered where the burden to pray that prayer came from. I had no boyfriend, so I had no name in my head or heart. God had just instructed me at the time that my current *toaster* was not my husband. Daddy didn't give me permission to “fall in” and so I told Mr Man “No”.

So, who was this man the Holy Spirit was tugging at me to pray for? I did not have answers but I prayed anyway. I had learned to pray in tongues when I didn't know what or exactly how to pray, and that I did. As I prayed, I made declarations on his job, workplace,

business, etc. Maybe he had issues at his workplace in that season. I do not know, I guess I will find out when he comes. However, for the rest of that year, I continued to periodically have strong urges to pray for him.

In June 2016, I again had the burden to pray for this man whose name I did not know. I reached out to a friend and told her to join me in prayers for our individual future husbands. She was also single but did not ignore me or act weird; and this is the reason I will always be grateful for spiritual friends who will not think twice before embarking on seemingly silly prayers.

We did pray and as I prayed, this book was born. I scribbled down words and prayers as they came from the Spirit in my journal. In fact, I wrote the entire book in the one hour *or more* prayer time I had.

This book has since then gone through growth and development just as is expected of every spiritual being or entity. The fact that you are reading this is proof that God has also put a burden for prayer on your heart. You do not have to know the name of your future husband to pray for him; and just as my friend joined me to pray, I invite you to pray too - for the one whose

The prayers in this book are written like letters. I have always written letters to the one whose name I don't know when I think about him; therefore, I decided to also let my heart show through the letters in this book.

but to pray them out loud - open your mouth and send up some sweet-smelling offerings unto God on behalf of your man. Then, you may go a step further as you read these letters; pick up your journal and write to your future husband, document every other prayer that the Lord leads you to pray.

Aside from the prayers in this book, the Holy Spirit not only knows your future husband's name, but knows his specific needs. It would be a blessing to share such a journal with your future husband when he arrives and confirms that your prayers on his behalf were all direly needed.

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## BEFORE YOU READ THIS BOOK

There is a burden in my heart that has been present for a long while. It is the burden I feel when I see single women so desperate for marriage; trying to fill the void only God can fill with a man. It is important for every woman reading this book to settle the fact that God is her first husband.

*“For your Maker is your husband-- the LORD Almighty is his name-- the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer; he is called the God of all the earth.”*

I first got the revelation that God is my first husband in the year 2014 and that revelation plunged me into a more intimate relationship with God – one where I could tell Him my secrets and worries or simply stay up at night chatting with Him or writing Him letters.

The revelation that Jesus is my husband before

any other physical husband simply took me into a life where I was full and immensely satisfied with Jesus. I could then set my priorities right – God first, His purpose for my life second, and the choice of marriage with my physical spouse next.

These priorities set me free from the desperation for marriage which seemed to plague so many ladies and as a natural consequence, I could clearly see my value as God’s bride and what kind of man my first husband (God) would want for me.

Isaiah 54:5 has forever set me free from trying to fill a God-sized void with a man-sized object. I still see so many good Christian women carrying this void around and it hurts me deeply. It hurts me because these ladies do not see or even realize that the void they think should be filled by a man can only be filled by God.

We have a lot of ladies going on mindless dates with men who the Word expressly bars them from marrying because they are “lonely”. I just want to tell

them “Honey, if you haven’t yet learned to let God fill you up to the point where loneliness isn’t an issue for you anymore; then no man on earth can give you the thrill your heart desires.”

Society has made superficial standards that pressure single women to think that they are incomplete when they do not yet have a ring on their “ring-finger”, but whose mind-set are you going to follow? God's or the society's?

*“Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is-- his good, pleasing and perfect will.”*

*-Romans 12:2*

Every time you are tempted to think that you are incomplete and need a man to fill you up, that is the exact moment that you are faced with a choice as to who you will believe. It is a time that you are faced with the decision of just how much you are willing to renew your mind and let God’s thoughts be your very own

thoughts.

The word says that Jesus is the only one who fills up all things everywhere with Himself.

*“God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made him head over all things for the benefit of the church.*

*And the church is his body; it is made full and complete by Christ, WHO FILLS ALL THINGS EVERYWHERE WITH HIMSELF”*

*-Ephesians 1:22&23*

You have to let God fill you up. Leaving that void for a man to fill is an unfair pressure on a man who is just like you - *human*.

You may get married and find yourself back to square one – dissatisfied with your life and irritated at everything around you; hating your husband’s shortcomings because you were not prepared for them – shortcomings that are to be expected, since your

husband is only a man with weaknesses like you.

Therefore, before you delve into this book, if you haven't yet found completion in Christ Jesus, I would love to ask you to take a moment to ask Him to come fill you now.

Your desire to get married is valid and God Himself knows that marriage is good, but a spouse can never take the place of God in your life.

You may have spent too many nights with the wrong men on dates you should never have been on. You may have spent too many years placing your life on hold; waiting for your joy to kick off when your husband arrives. But Jesus Himself says that He has come to give you life that flows till it overflows (John 10:10).

This overflowing life doesn't start when you get a husband; it begins when you surrender your heart and love life to Jesus. Like the woman at the well who had 5 husbands and couldn't be satisfied or fulfilled by any,

please, recognize that only Jesus can make you whole (John 4).

Your full life in Christ can start right now too. Simply say the prayer below with all your heart.

*Lord, I am sorry about the times I have been so dissatisfied with the life you have graciously given to me...*

*I am sorry for making marriage an idol...*

*I am sorry for placing and predicating my happiness and joy on the husband who is coming without realizing that you are my first husband...*

*I have been so desperate for marriage, pushing you to the side and going along with men that I know you don't approve of...*

*I am sorry Lord, I am sorry.*

*I am here now Lord. Here in fullness of body, mind, heart and spirit.*

*Please come fill me up Lord. Come fill me up to satisfaction.*

*Let my life be made complete by and in you.*

*Let my desire for you be deeper than my desire for my earthly marriage.*

*I surrender my marital destiny to you; you determine my*

*spouse, and you determine the timing.*

*Just come fill me up Lord, from now on, let me experience the completion that only you can give to me, in Jesus name I have prayed, amen.*

Congratulations if you just said that prayer.

Get ready to follow-up on your words and start fellowshiping with Jesus, not only on a God scale but on a husband scale.

Wake in the morning and pour your love on Him.

Go on date nights with the Lord, just basking in the joy He gives you.

Tell Him your struggles, pain and joy; lay yourself bare before Him.

Write Him love letters; read and study His love letters to you in His Word (Romans 8 is a good start).

Move from your routine relationship to that of a beautiful marriage. You are His bride - a bride He loved and deemed worth dying for.

Even when He brings your physical husband, He will still remain your husband. When you get to heaven and the physical marriage fades away, your marriage with Him will remain till eternity.

I believe that we are all on equal footing right now; as sisters who would not pray the prayers in this book anxiously but in quiet assurance that our first husband has our physical husband firmly fixed in the palm of His hands. We now know that our first husband is and would always be the only one who completes us.

As we enjoy such a beautiful marriage with our eternal bridegroom; it would also set the foundation for our marriage with our physical bridegroom. So, we pray as led by the Spirit for our physical bridegrooms, trusting that every prayer sown will be seeds that will speak in his life, manifesting fruits even before we are joined by God as husband and wife.

## HOW TO READ THIS BOOK

When I was at Nigerian Law School in the year 2014, I had a roommate whose call to my sister on her 17<sup>th</sup> birthday included prayers for her future husband. I stood listening to the conversation and at the end of the call I jokingly remarked that “my sister is just 17!” Her reply was classic; she said “we are supposed to start praying for our marriage and husbands right from childhood, this is even late” (paraphrased).

Today, 3 years later, I totally agree with her. You know, today's Christian woman has a lot of gap to fill when it comes to prayers for her man/marriage. Somehow, we have tilted more into worries that can do nothing instead of tilting to prayers that can do everything.

*“And who of you by worrying and being anxious can add one unit of measure (cubit) to his stature or to the span of his life?”*

*-Matthew 6:27, AM*

This book is meant to teach you how you can do more with the one weapon that can do everything – prayer.

*“...The heartfelt and persistent prayer of a righteous man (believer) can accomplish much [when put into action and made effective by God – it is dynamic and can have tremendous power].”*

*-James 5:16b, AMP*

You know, sometimes Christians feel like prayers accomplish nothing. We often feel this, even about people we know. Now, to add to that, this book is about to take it a notch higher- to praying for someone whose name we do not even know.

But know this:

How we feel does not matter; as Christians, the Word is our only truth.

Do not think that your prayers accomplish nothing; in the James 5:16 passage above, we are assured that every heartfelt prayer from a believer accomplishes much in the hand of God.

*“It is dynamic and can have tremendous power.”*

And that's exactly what this book aims to teach you to do – to pray earnest, heartfelt and constant Spirit-led prayers for the one whose name you don't know, staying secure in the knowledge that every word of prayer is being worked on to accomplish its intended result by God.

*“Then another angel with a gold incense burner came and stood at the altar. And a great amount of incense was given to him to mix with the prayers of God's people as an offering on the gold altar before the throne.*

*The smoke of the incense, mixed with the prayers of God's holy people, ascended up to God from the altar where the angel had poured them out.”*

Know that every one of the prayers of God's people are sweet-smelling incense before Him, with which He disposes angels to go and do His bidding.

## PRAYERS FOR YOUR FUTURE HUSBAND

As I shared in the introduction, the prayers of this book are written like letters with words flowing from my heart to the Lord. To get the best results from this book, you also must offer up sweet-smelling incense from your heart to the Lord.

Do not just read the letters; get your own journal and as you pray, write down specific prayers the Holy Spirit lays in your heart for your man. Then, go further and pray these Holy Spirit inspired prayers after writing them.

The section titled “Your armour of truth” contains Bible passages for each day that can be confessed and spoken out loud concerning the specific area that you are praying about. Please, make the prayers and sections as personal as you possibly can. Make the confessions of Bible passages personal by putting in your name/your future husband's name.

Feel free to simply say “my future husband” if you do not know him yet. The Holy Spirit knows Him and will direct each prayer and confession as needed.

## HOW TO READ THIS BOOK

You will also find a section after each day's prayer in this book titled "Your personal love letter". In this section, you can write down details of your thoughts or whatever comes to mind concerning your husband/marriage as you pray. This is especially useful if you do not have a journal ready at hand.

There are 21 prayers in this book; each dealing with 21 different aspects of a husband's life. Please, do not be in haste; take them one day at a time. Each day is another opportunity to offer up a prayer for the one whose name you do not know.

The prayers can be better done as a 21 day prayer challenge for your future husband. It will challenge you to imbibe it as a conscious daily habit. This challenge can be done with a prayer journal where you do not just write down your prayers for your man, but also write down thoughts that you would have told him if he was with you.

It would help if you have your journal placed in a visible spot to remind you to keep on praying for 'him'.

I have found the benefits of keeping a journal to be immense and I encourage you to join me.

For you, the lady who still struggles with a bit of void in your heart from the absence of a man, I hope that you experience that joy that comes from lifting up your thoughts to the Lord both in prayer and in writing.

The best way to read this book is to immerse yourself in it; let the letters herein lead you to pour out your heart to God, while offering your supplication to the Lord. Do not read this book with the author's voice but read with your heart open to see the possibilities in your own marital life that prayer can produce.

Please, pray for your future husband; he needs it. Someday soon when you share your prayer journal with him as a gift, you will know just how much your prayers for his life were really needed at the very moment you prayed them.

## DAY 1

### PRAYERS FOR SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY

Dear Future Hubby,

I woke up yesterday morning with the words “spiritual authority” ringing in my head.

I went to sit at my prayer spot still thinking about those words. As I began to pray, I thought of Job and later on, checked his story in the Bible.

I saw this:

*“When the parties were over, Job would get up early in the morning and sacrifice a burnt offering for each of his children, thinking, “Maybe one of them sinned by defying God inwardly.” Job made a habit of this sacrificial atonement, just in case they’d sinned.”*

*Job 1:5, MSG*

Job was an upright man who feared God and hated evil. But, more than that, He was also a man who

stood in the gap for his children.

He had spiritual authority over the lives of his children, asking for forgiveness for their sins and offering them up in purity to God. NLT version says that this was Job's regular practice.

He wasn't just concerned about his own salvation and righteousness but also about those of his children. He stood in the gap for them and used his spiritual authority to cover his home.

Job understood what I hope you already know; that the path of the children can be determined and drawn up by a father who stays on his knees for his children, pleading their case before God.

I believe that our kids Deborah, Daniel and David are children who will sing of God's name and deeds to their generation and you, their father, will lead them on that path.

I know you need some help, so I am praying for

you:

- ◆ Lord, I thank you that my future husband is saved. I thank you that his heart is hidden in your hands.
- ◆ I ask that you teach him your ways; teach him how to wield spiritual authority under you as a husband and father.
- ◆ Let him be able to teach our children the way of the Lord both with his words, attitude and character.
- ◆ Let him learn true fatherhood from you God. He is taught by you and leads our kids right by his behaviour, attitude and words.
- ◆ Fill him up with the grace that comes from you, to be able to be the spiritual leader over our household in Jesus name, amen.
